- "panel structure of the independent expert advisory review panel
- the reports, findings and recommendations drafted by the panel."

The expert advisory panel was comprised of five members, including chair Charlotte von Dadelszen. Members were selected for their skills, expertise and knowledge of working in sectors that interact with the operations of the Public Works Act including land acquisition and disposals, infrastructure asset management, engineering, treaty negotiations and local government.
