I refer to your request for information dated 10 December 2024 made under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). You requested:

“Could you please provide the cumulative GPA of all students who studied an LLB, Bcom with a major in Finance from the years 2020-2024 inclusive (ie have finished their studies by the end of semester 2 2024 and will subsequently graduate with both degrees). This need not exclude students who are studying a double major or have an additional minor for their Bcom.

Moreover, please provide the same but broaden the scope to include all students who studied an LLB, Bcom (all maj.) from the years 2020-2024 inclusive (ie have finished their studies by the end of semester 2 2024 and will subsequently graduate with both degrees).

Finally, please broaden the scope further to include all students who studied an LLB from the years 2020-24 (inclusive) and finished their studies by the end of semester 2 2024 and will subsequently graduate. ie this will include all other majors for a (possible) second degree.

Please let me know if you have any questions. To confirm, the response data will consist of three lists.”

Subject to the following comments, please see **attached** the information you have requested:

- the data is correct as at 16 December 2024.
- table #1 refers to the cumulative GPAs of all students who completed an LLB between 2020 – 2024.
- table #2 refers to the cumulative GPAs of all students who completed an LLB and a BCom (any major) between 2020 – 2024.
- table #3 refers to the cumulative GPAs of all students who completed an LLB and a BCom (major in Finance) between 2020 – 2024.
- as noted in our email of 16 December 2024, the cumulative GPA calculations include any and all paper results to date, including any paper results following the completion of the LLB, as we are unable to provide a “snapshot” of cumulative GPA as at a specific date (e.g., 31 December 2021).
- the LLB completion data for each dataset includes students enrolled in the LLB(Hons) programme.

- our references to “completed” or “completions” indicate students who were eligible to graduate. Students who chose to [defer](#) their graduation are included in the data.

I trust that this information will be helpful.

If you are not satisfied with our response to your information request, section 28(3) of the Act provides you with the right to ask an Ombudsman to investigate and review this response. However, we would welcome the opportunity to discuss any concerns with you first.
