*Please provide the risk assessment for the invasive seaweed Asparagopsis taxiformis. Also, why did MPI choose not to proactively release the A. taxiformis risk assessment?* 

Please find attached as Appendix One, a copy of scientific technical advice regarding the risk assessment for macroalga *Asparagopsis taxiformis*. Please note some information has been withheld as 'out-of-scope' as it doesn't relate to the information being released.
