## Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) to the Ministry of Health – Manatū Hauora (the Ministry) on 22 January 2025. You requested:

"Please may I know who the panel, consultants, specialists, and clinicians that are reviewing Puberty Blockers in NZ. Their names, qualifications and the organisations they work for."

I have interpreted your request as querying who is leading the Ministry's work related to the prescribing of puberty blockers in gender-affirming care. The Ministry undertook consultation on the prescribing of puberty blockers on behalf of the Minister of Health. The Ministry's work is being co-led by myself as Associate Deputy Director-General, Strategy, Policy and Legislation, and Dr Joe Bourne, the Ministry's Chief Medical Officer, representing both policy and medical expertise.
