I refer to your Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) request dated 15 February 2025 for information in relation to infringement notice PR7391696.

You requested:

*I wish to know HOW and BY WHOM pseudo driver licences are created. Are pseudo driver licences legal? What legislation makes them legal?*

Please be advised that as the above infringement notice is being set down for a court hearing and you have already directed your questions towards Police Prosecutions, your request is therefore refused under section 18(da) of the OIA on the basis that you are the defendant and your request for information is currently being sought under the Criminal Disclosure Act 2008 (CDA).

With respect to your previous request IR-01-24-42855, I would like to apologise on behalf of Police as you were not informed that your request was being treated in accordance with the CDA. Moving forward, could you please direct all additional correspondence to the relevant prosecutor, who I see you have already been in contact with since last year.
