Thank you for your email of 18 February 2025 to Te Kaunihera o Pōneke | Wellington City Council (the Council) requesting the following information:

- *Could you please supply the latest seismic assessment report for the block of flats located at 16 Glenmore Street, Thorndon known as Te Whare Ahuru.*

Your request has been considered under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA).

Jenni Tipler - Manager Resilient Buildings, confirmed that she spoke with you on Tuesday, 25 February 2025, to clarify what specific information you were requesting.
