Dear Brian,

I enclose pictures posted showing the "diplomas" that have now been given to those "graduated" on May 3. more than a month after the "graduation" in June.

The diplomas are invalid and fraudulent. A tutor was fired to remove him from the scene on the pretext he had failed to submit grades but in fact he was unable to given that May 3 made the allocation of grades now impossible as their "diplomas" had been conferred. Exzur Peralta has paid for another marker to grade the papers, such grades being invalid if after May 3 and fraudulent if pre dated before May 3.

Furthermore 70% is a pass at IANZ and how is it possible everyone achieved 70% or above unless directed to assign such grades.

Mr Reginald James only recently completed his grades and Miss Jill Mantos could not have passed his paper and she was in Palmerston North doing her CAP when his paper was taught. It is astonishing.

There are 97 likes for this including most of the others who have been given "diplomas" and who participated in the fraud of May 3.

Multiple this by the other 20 students and you can see the damage occurring here.

You will see Mr Exzur Peralta and his wife, Zarah Peralta flanking these students. They are the orchestrators of all of this.

All of this, and much else besides, is likely to feature soon on a television investigative journalism programme. The last time I saw you was the first time I had heard from them but since then it has gone much further. I am letting you know this as a matter of courtesy and in the interests of transparency and openness of the process.

The latest further outrage of diplomas now handed out is just further proof that IANZ has no intention of stopping its practices.

You will soon have these students handing in copies of this "diploma" as evidence of their right to pursue a work search visa and this will happen before the channel 3 programme airs.

I am not sure how NZQA is handling this but I trust they will act as the mandated authority might be expected to act, representing the New Zealand public interest. In any event, it will be in the public arena soon enough and I promised to keep you updated on this.

Dear Brian,

I enclose pictures posted showing the "diplomas" that have now been given to those "graduated" on May 3. more than a month after the "graduation" in June.

The diplomas are invalid and fraudulent. A tutor was fired to remove him from the scene on the pretext he had failed to submit grades but in fact he was unable to give that May 3 made the allocation of grades now impossible as their "diplomas" had been conferred. Exzur Peralta has paid for another marker to grade the papers, such grades being invalid if after May 3 and fraudulent if pre dated before May 3.

Furthermore 70% is a pass at IANZ and how is it possible everyone achieved 70% or above unless directed to assign such grades.

Mr Reginald James only recently completed his grades and Miss Jill Mantos could not have passed his paper and she was in Palmerston North doing her CAP when his paper was taught. It is astonishing.

Please go to the Facebook page of Mr Ryan Guterrez to see the "diploma" being proudly displayed, a full month after the graduation.

There are 97 likes for this including most of the others who have been given "diplomas" and who participated in the fraud of May 3.

Multiple this by the other 20 students and you can see the damage occurring here.

You will see Mr Exzur Peralta and his wife, Zarah Peralta flanking these students. They are the orchestrators of all of this.

All of this, and much else besides, is likely to feature soon on a television investigative journalism programme. The last time I saw you was the first time I had heard from them but since then it has gone much further. I am letting you know this as a matter of courtesy and in the interests of transparency and openness of the process.

The latest further outrage of diplomas now handed out is just further proof that IANZ has no intention of stopping its practices.

You will soon have these students handing in copies of this "diploma" as evidence of their right to pursue a work search visa and this will happen before the channel 3 programme airs.

I am not sure how NZQA is handling this but I trust they will act as the mandated authority might be expected to act, representing the New Zealand public interest. In any event, it will be in the public arena soon enough and I promised to keep you updated on this.
