Your request under the Official Information Act 1982

I refer to your email of 20 October 2015 requesting information under the Official Information Act 1982 (**the Act**) regarding a meeting between myself and Iwi of the Eastern Bay of Plenty and myself in Opotiki on 4 October 2015:

1. *"The names and positions of all those present at the meeting; and*
2. *Correspondence from and to the Minister and his staff in relation to the above meeting; and*
3. *Documents made or held by the Minister and his staff in relation to the above meeting including any minutes taken, advice given to the Minister, and emails prior to or subsequent to the above meeting."*

I have considered your request and enclose the following documents listed at Appendix One in response to your request. Please note that parts of certain documents have been withheld under the Act pursuant to sections:

- a. 9(2)(a) to protect the privacy of natural persons;
- b. 9(2)(b)(ii) to protect information that would be likely to unreasonably prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information;
- c. 9(2)(g)(i) to maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinions between officials; and
- d. 9(2)(j) to enable a Minister of the Crown or any department or organisation holding the information to carry on, without prejudice or disadvantage, negotiations.

Please note the parts of the documents not relevant to your request have also been redacted.

I trust that this letter, and the attached documents, answers your request for information.

Under section 28(3) of the Act you may, if you wish, contact the Ombudsman seeking investigation and a review of the decision to withhold certain information.

Ngāitai

Background

1. Ngāitai (ki Tōrere) is a small iwi located in the eastern Bay of Plenty (see **attached** area of interest map). In 2014 the Crown assessed Ngāitai's population as 2,203 for quantum purposes.
2. The table below provides further background information.

Status of Negotiations

3. The Crown recognised Ngāitai's deed of mandate in June 2014. Subsequently, we met with Ngāitai on 18 November 2014 to provide an overview of the Treaty settlements process generally. There has been no substantial progress in negotiations since that time.

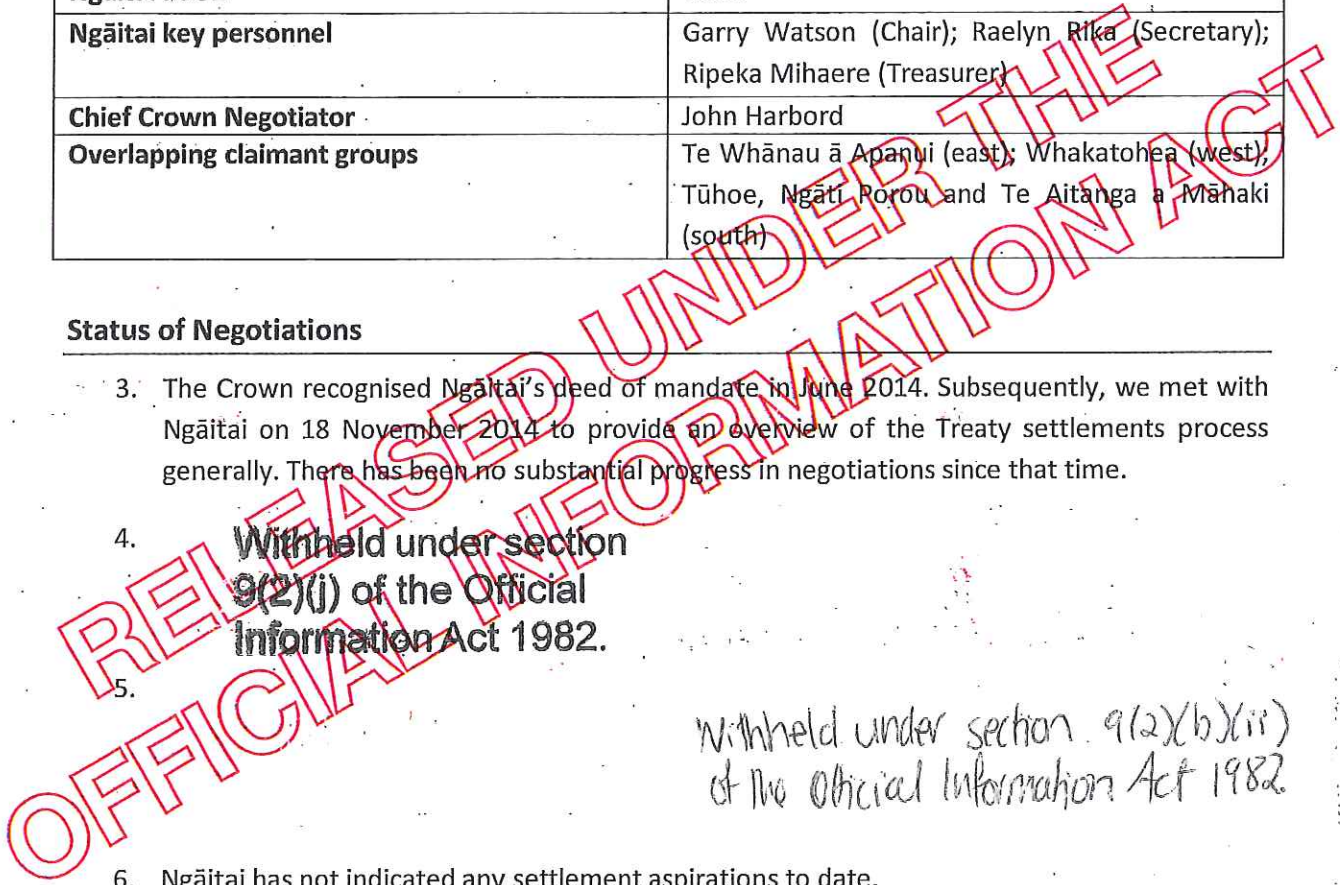

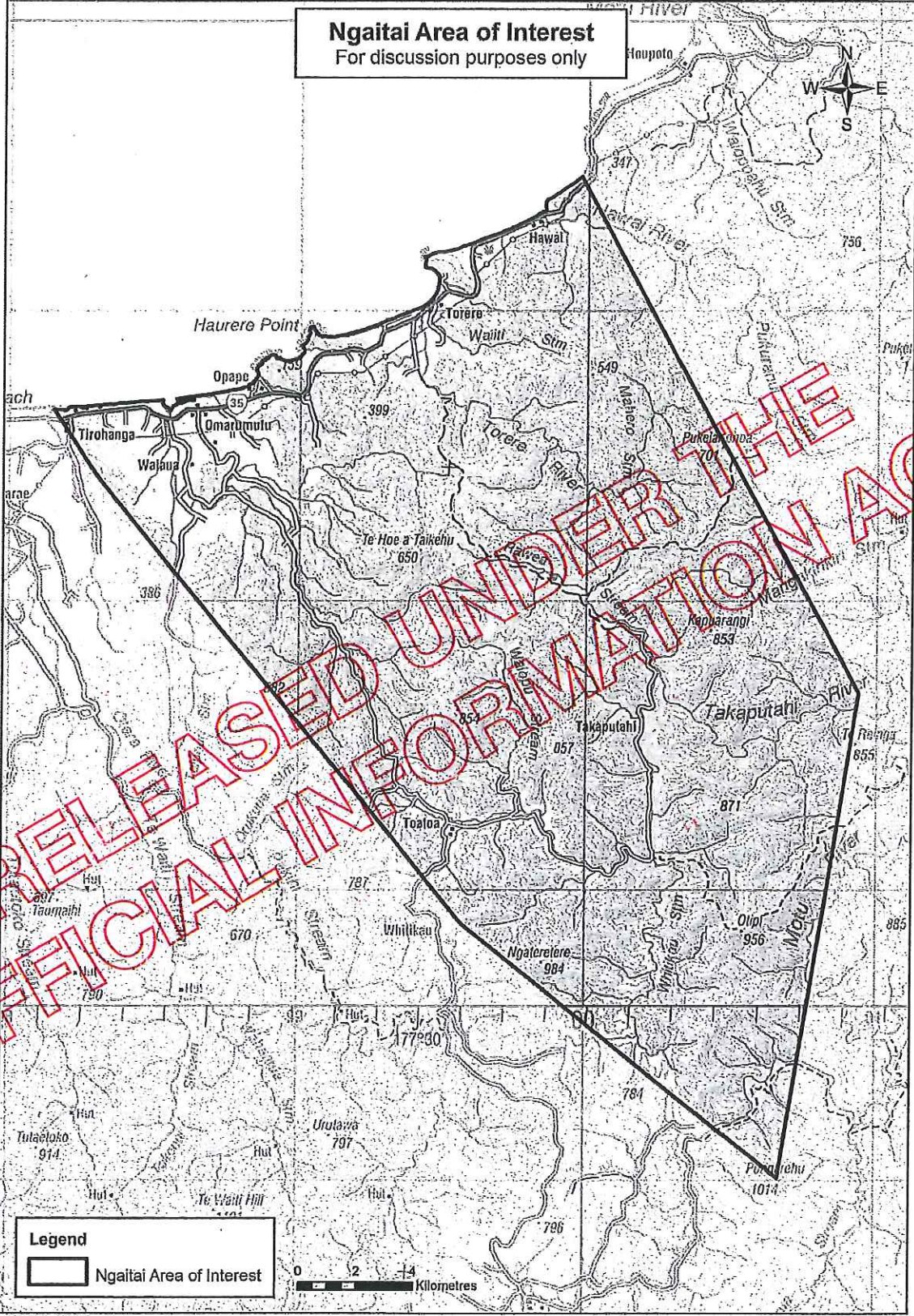

Purpose

- This briefing provides you with background information for your meeting with Whakatōhea, Ngāitai (ki Tōrere) and Te Whānau ā Apanui iwi representatives on Sunday 4 October 2015.

Meeting details

- You are meeting with Whakatōhea, Ngāitai (ki Tōrere) and Te Whānau ā Apanui representatives at the Whakatōhea Māori Trust Board Office in Opotiki (11.15 am – 11.45 am). The meeting is scheduled for 30 minutes. Representatives attending are:

Iwi	Representatives
Whakatōhea	Graeme Biesterer, Chairperson Tū Ake Whakatōhea Robert Edwards, Chairperson Whakatōhea Māori Trust Board Iwi kaumātua
Ngāitai (ki Tōrere)	Gary Watson, Chairperson Ngāitai Iwi Authority Iwi kaumātua
Te Whānau ā Apanui	Matetu Herewini, Chairperson Te Rūnanga o Te Whānau Rikirangi Gage, Negotiator Iwi kaumātua

- The purpose of the meeting is to encourage Whakatōhea, Ngāitai (ki Tōrere) and Te Whānau ā Apanui to move their respective Treaty settlements forward. We understand that in addition to this focus you are interested in exploring ideas for a regional approach to Treaty settlement negotiations (see **Appendix 1** iwi map of region)

Mr Mair will attend the meeting. Doris Johnston, Deputy Director Policy and Special Projects, at the Office of Treaty Settlements (OTS) will attend the meeting.

5. Background information on each iwi group is provided below as follows:

- Whakatōhea (paragraphs 6-18) – led by TPK;
- Ngāti (ki Tōrere) (paragraphs 19-25) – led by OTS; and
- Te Whānau ā Apanui (paragraphs 26-39) – led by OTS

Whakatōhea

6. There are five groups seeking to represent part or the whole of Whakatōhea in a Treaty settlement with the Crown:

- Whakatōhea Māori Trust Board;
- Tū Ake Whakatōhea Collective;
- Whakatōhea Raupatu Working Party;
- Te Ūpokorehe Treaty Claims Trust; and
- Te Whānau a Mōkomoko.

7. Of these groups, officials are working with the Tū Ake Whakatōhea Collective (**Tū Ake Collective**) and Whakatōhea Raupatu Working Party (**the Working Party**) supported by the Whakatōhea Māori Trust Board (**the Trust Board**), to form a single entity to negotiate a Whakatōhea Treaty settlement with the Crown.

9. In 2013 officials provided comment to Tū Ake Collective on their October 2013 draft mandate strategy. Officials similarly provided comment to the Working Party on their draft mandate strategy submitted in March 2013.

10. In December 2013, officials provided both groups with a draft mandate strategy combining the commonalities of their mandate strategies as a working document to assist these groups to work together.

Since 2013 officials have continued to encourage the Tū Ake Collective and the Working Party to work together and promote with the other Whakatōhea groups the development of a single mandate strategy and the establishment of a single Whakatōhea entity to represent Whakatōhea in Treaty settlement negotiations with the Crown.

12. To help move mandate activity forward in May 2015 Ken Mair was appointed to the role of Crown Facilitator for Whakatōhea.

14. Mr Mair has met with the Tū Ake Collective, the Working Party and Te Ūpokorehe to promote a collective approach and the establishment of a single Whakatōhea mandated entity. Mr Mair has also got groups to consider the Tū Ake Collective's draft mandate strategy.

19. Ngāitai (ki Tōrere) is a small iwi located in the eastern Bay of Plenty. In 2014 the Crown assessed Ngāitai's population as 2,203 for quantum purposes.

20. In June 2014 the Crown recognised the mandate of the Ngāitai Iwi Authority (**the Authority**) to represent Ngāitai in Treaty settlement negotiations with the Crown. Officials met with the Authority on 18 November 2014 to provide an overview of the Treaty settlements process. Since this meeting there has been no substantial progress in their Treaty settlement negotiations.

26. In 2010 the Crown recognised a conditional mandate for Te Rūnanga o Te Whānau (Te Rūnanga) to negotiate a Te Whānau ā Apanui Treaty settlement subject to the following conditions;

- completion of a mutually agreed mandate strategy;
- implementation of agreed mandate strategy;
- completion of a robust and transparent mandate process that leads to a deed of mandate for joint Ministers' recognition; and
- completion of Terms of Negotiation.

38. To help progress discussions with Te Whānau ā Apanui Ken Mair was appointed to the role of Crown Facilitator for Te Whānau ā Apanui in May 2015. Mr Mair has initiated individual discussions with Te Whānau ā Apanui negotiators and Te Rūnanga members to gain an understanding of the leadership of these groups, their relationships and their perspectives on Treaty settlements.

39. To bolster Te Whānau ā Apanui Treaty settlement negotiations impetus Mr Mair has begun discussions with the Te Whānau ā Apanui negotiators and Te Rūnanga regarding their Treaty settlement aspirations. Mr Mair considers this might be a useful way to stimulate more formal and robust conversations with Te Whānau ā Apanui to further deed of mandate progress.

Kia ora, here is a short note re the meeting I attended in Opotiki on Sunday 4 October at the Whakatohea Maori Trust Board Offices in Opotiki.

Attendees:

Crown: Minister Finlayson (MFTOWN) and Minister Flavell (MFMD)
Ken Mair, Crown Facilitator and Doris Johnston, OTS

Iwi: 12 attendees representing the three iwi including: Graeme Riesterer, Robert Edwards, Tangi (? query that this name is right) (from Ngaitai), Rikirangi Gage, matetu Herewini.

Iwi comments and Ministers response:

Te Whanau a Apanui:

The iwi continues to move forward but have not yet finalised a mandate, but feel that hapu have given a mandate. The iwi would like to progress their MACA determination at the same time as their historic Treaty Settlement negotiations. They had a question about the what the Crown's view was on negotiations with hapu within Te Whanau a Apanui.

MFTOWN responded: that while MACA and Settlements are two different processes he was happy to look at whether Whanua a Apanui could progress both together, but he was clear that at this stage he was not promising that could be achieved. He clarified that he wanted to negotiate with LNG's not individual hapu

The Minister said he would look at the MACA issue but offered no guarantee that a joint settlement and MACA process would be possible.
