

Gift Deed For The Royal New Zealand Chaplains Department Paintings And Images.

Introduction

1. This Deed describes the gifting, use of, control and disposal of Six Paintings and digital images presented to the Royal New Zealand Chaplains Department (RNZChD) by Lt Col M. Subritzky (donator).

Description

2. This gift consists of six original water colour paintings being the Papakura, Waiouru, Linton, Trentham and Burnham Chapels and the RNZChD Corp Crest. The gift also includes the digital images of the six paintings.

Use

3. The digital images of these painting are to be used for the production of prints to be presented to RNZChD Chaplains on their release from service and the number of images used to create the individual prints will be determined by the RNZChD Regimental Colonel.

4. The presentation of prints as a gift will be to RNZChD Chaplains who make the level of Chaplain Class 3 or higher. In recognition of their length of service and that they are now Senior Chaplains within RNZChD Corp.

5. Prints are to be sequentially numbered and the RNZChD Corp Fund Secretary is to keep a record of the print numbers and who they are presented to.

Control

6. The six original paintings are to be held and secured by the Regimental Colonel (PC (A)) of the RNZChD as custodian of the images. The digital images are to be held by the Corp Fund Secretary and may only be used for presentations and may not be used without the approval of the Regimental Colonel.

Disposal

7. In the event of the RNZChD Corp being disbanded or it is determined for any other reason that the original paintings and images are no longer to be used; they shall be returned to the donator. In the event that he can not be located or has passed away, the original paints and images are to be donated to the Army Museum, Waiouru.
