The Pūhoro STEMM (Pūhoro) delivers a range of STEMM activities and initiatives as part of an agreement with NZQA. Pūhoro currently delivers its services in Northland, Auckland, Waikato, Rotorua, Hawke's Bay, Manawatū, and Christchurch.
