

NEW CONTRIBUTORY FACTOR CODES	
118	Inappropriate speed for road conditions
	An additional speed factor code introduced to take account of road conditions.
119	Inappropriate speed for weather conditions
	An additional speed factor code introduced to take account of weather conditions.
221	Impaired non-driver (pedestrian /cyclist/passenger, etc.)
	To be used when a drug impaired non-driver interferes with a driver and that interference causes a crash.
220	Other drugs
	A new 'drugs' category has been introduced. Drugs codes were previously included in the 'alcohol' category, but now warrant a separate category.
364	Attention diverted by vehicle console inbuilt features: radio/heater/etc.
	Split out from old factor code 358 (Cigarette, radio, heater, AC, glove box, obj under drivers feet/pedals etc) to provide a more specific category on how driver was distracted.
365	Attention diverted by objects under driver's pedals
	Split out from old factor code 358 (Cigarette, radio, heater, AC, glove box, obj under drivers feet/pedals etc) to provide a more specific category on how driver was distracted.
366	Attention diverted by food, cigarettes, beverages, etc
	Split out from old factor code 358 (Cigarette, radio, heater, AC, glove box, obj under drivers feet/pedals etc) to provide a more specific category on how driver was distracted. For example, this code now includes food, beverages, applying make-up, finding, lighting or dropping a cigarette or other driver actions that distracts the driver.
508	Other disability
	A new 'disability' category has been introduced. Disability codes were previously included in the 'illness' category, but now warrant a separate category.
518	Intentional or criminal action - over the speed limit
	An additional speed factor code introduced to take account of the <u>intention</u> of the driver.
535	Reason for death or injury - electrocution
	New factor code introduced to provide a more specific category on reason for death or injury.
536	Reason for death or injury - unsecured child seat
	New factor code introduced to provide a more specific category on reason for death or injury.
537	Reason for death or injury - child restrained failure/inappropriate
	New factor code introduced to provide a more specific category on reason for death or injury.
608	Confusing/dazzling lights
	New factor code introduced to provide further detail on how lights influenced the crash.
609	Lights or reflectors at fault or dirty
	New factor code introduced to provide further detail on how faulty or dirty lights influenced the crash.

CRASH ANALYSIS SYSTEM
RATIONALE FOR NEW CONTRIBUTORY FACTOR CODES
For use from 1 January 2016

733	Pedestrian from or to scheduled service
	New factor code introduced to provide a specific category to include, for example, pedestrians running for a bus or school children getting off a bus.
740	Pedestrian crossing road - looking the wrong way
	New factor code introduced to provide a specific category for pedestrians that look the wrong way, cross a road regardless and step into the path of an oncoming vehicle or bus.
828	Slippery road surface - steel/iron covers and joints
	New factor code introduced to take account, for example, manhole covers. This code will mostly apply to crashes involving motorbikes.
829	Visibility limited by signs/billboards/hoardings
	New factor code introduced to provide a more specific category for when visibility is limited by a sign, billboard or hoarding.
849	Visibility limited by traffic signs
	New factor code introduced to provide a more specific category for when visibility is limited by traffic signs. For example, a driver has to pull forward too far from traffic sign in order to get visibility.
856	Barriers necessary
	New factor code introduced to provide more specific guidance to Police of where the reporting officer considers that the introduction of a barrier could have helped prevent the incident.
857	Island necessary
	New factor code introduced to provide more specific guidance to Police of where the reporting officer considers that the introduction of an island could have helped prevent the incident.
697	Vehicle software failure
	New factor code introduced to provide a more specific category for when new vehicle technologies fail. For example, when adaptive cruise control or automatic headlights fail and contribute to a crash.
