I refer to your email dated 15 March 2016 in which you requested information about NZ Police's contract with Lockheed Martin Global, Inc.

You have asked for the following information:

- *What services or goods does Lockheed Martin currently provide to NZ Police?*

Lockheed Martin Global, Inc. currently provides the following services to NZ Police;

- Warehousing and Distribution Services including the procurement and purchasing of Police specific uniform and accoutrements (excluding weaponry)
- Light Engineering and Manufacturing works
- Technical support services for Police's tactical training simulator
- Logistics support services as required on a case by case basis


- *What is the duration of the contract?*

NZ Police joined the Project Alexander Agreement for Provision of Agile Logistics on 17th March 2010. The term of the Agreement is as follows;

- Initial term: 10 years
- Right of renewals: four further periods of 5 years each

You have the right, under section 28(3) of the Official Information Act 1982, to ask the Ombudsman to review my decision if you are not satisfied with the way I have responded to your request.
