Dear Aaron

Request made under the Official Information Act 1982.

Thank you for the following request, received on 26 September 2016:

- *On Friday 23rd September at around 6.45pm there was a vehicle accident involving three cars approximately at these coordinates: -36.819244, 174.750124 — right next to the Motorway barrier mover shed, across from the police station*
- *I was heading southbound towards Auckland City, between Stafford St and the Shelly Beach road exits.*
- *The officer in attendance mentioned that one/some of the CCTV cameras may have caught some footage of the incident.*
- *Are you able to confirm and please provide a copy of the footage if it does indeed exist?*

The Transport Agency generally only holds camera footage for a short period before the footage is overwritten. While we will assist Police investigations where we can, footage is held primarily for the purpose of operating the transport network.

Unfortunately we no longer hold the footage you have requested. Accordingly, I am refusing your request under section 18(g)(i) of the Official Information Act 1982 as the information requested is not held by the Transport Agency, and we have no grounds for believing that the information is held by another public agency.
