Thank you for contacting Auckland Transport on 11 August 2017 requesting CCTV footage of an incident at the intersection of Fred Taylor Drive and Fernhill Drive, Westgate on 30 July 2017, between 8:00pm and 8:30pm. We are very sorry to hear of your accident.

The purpose of the CCTV surveillance is to better manage the road network, not as a primary security tool. Therefore the incident you have mentioned may not have been recorded. Where footage of a specific incident or alleged crime is available, Auckland Transport provides footage to New Zealand Police upon receipt of a request from them.

Notwithstanding the above, in this instance a review of the footage reveals that we do not hold any recording of the specific incident. Your request is therefore declined under Section 17(e) of the LGOIMA as the information you are requesting does not exist.

We trust this information has addressed the matters raised however you have the right in accordance with section 27(3) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA) to make a complaint to the Office of the Ombudsman if you are not satisfied with our response.
