**Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA)**  
**AT2013/008604**

Thank you for your email dated 17 February 2013, which Auckland Transport received on the same date requesting statistics on public transport emissions per passenger kilometre, or the amount of fuel used per passenger kilometre, for the three different modes of public transport.

Bus and Ferry services are not directly operated by Auckland Transport and therefore, under section 17(e) of the LGOIMA 1987, your request for fuel consumption data relating to these services has been refused as Auckland Transport do not hold this information. However, for bus services, there is an on-going programme of replacement with the latest available diesel technology buses. Operators are acquiring the latest Euro 5 low emission buses now and currently approximately 18% operate using this technology.

Fuel usage and passenger kilometres for the rail network are provided below as per your request:
