Dear Mr Mills,

Thank you for your email of 14 May 2018 requesting under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA), the following information:

"Can you please provide access to all training materials provided to Business Migration Team staff members within Immigration New Zealand with specific reference to how they are trained to assess entrepreneur work visa and entrepreneur residence visa applications.

Any documents that assist the Business Migration Team staff members in assessing applications would also be appreciated, for example relevant VisaPak's or directions from management."

I am writing to advise you that the Ministry will provide a response but needs to extend the time available to answer your request. The Ministry's response will be with you no later than 29 June 2018. The reason for the extension relies on s15A(1)(b) of the OIA - consultations necessary to make a decision on the request are such that a proper response to the request cannot be made within the original time limit.
