We have two comments:

One very important point is to take out references to "Motorway" as it is not a motorway. It is a 60km/hr arterial. We recommend you call it "East West Link" throughout.

The second point is in regard to the letter and we would ask that the wording of the below para have the context added around the Board's being consulted as part of GPS development. New wording which we ask you consider inserting is in capitals below:
