Information Request – Full breakdown of FENZ costs - Korean Fishing Boat fire Port of Timaru

I refer to your official information request dated 4 July 2018 asking for the following information:

On the 9th April 2018 the Korean fishing vessel Dong Won 701 caught fire at the Port of Timaru. A major effort was required with FENZ resources bought in from around NZ to extinguish this fire. Please provide a full breakdown of FENZ costs involved in the containment and extinction of this fire.

The following table provides a breakdown of the fire suppression costs relating to the vessel Dong Won 701. Note that the cost totals may still be subject to change as it can a number of months for all costs to be accounted for.
