Re: AT2013/022983

I refer to your enquiry to the New Zealand Transport Agency on 2 May 2013 and subsequently transferred to Auckland Transport requesting a copy of any work undertaken on the Eastern Highway since 2008.

I can advise that Auckland Transport has not undertaken any further work on the Eastern Transport Corridor (ETC) project, Eastern Highway through Auckland's eastern suburbs (Glen Innes to CBD via Orakei Basin) since 2007.

Auckland City Council commissioned a new study called the Auckland Manukau Eastern Transport Initiative (AMETI) in 2005, the extent of which does not include the part of the former ETC project north of Glen Innes. However, a portion of the previous ETC designation south of Glen Innes (between Merton Road and Tainui Road) is proposed to be used to construct a new road in the near future (2017-2018). The ETC designation south of Tainui Road is not proposed to be used for the AMETI project.


