I refer to your Official Information Act request of 6 October 2018 for information relating to Police pursuits in the Auckland area.

## You requested:

 Could you please provide statistics of pursuits throughout Auckland, organised as a table by area, with resolutions (e.g number of abandoned, number of apprehended, number of fatal/injury) between 2014-2018? Please organise by area e.g East Auckland, Auckland city etc.

New Zealand Police publishes fleeing driver data online at http://www.police.govt.nz. Police Pursuits in the Auckland area can be found under 'Publications', 'Road policing driver offence data'. This data includes the number of pursuits with fleeing drivers by Police district and area as well as the number of these pursuits that were abandoned and those that resulted in injuries or fatalities. Therefore your request is refused pursuant to section 18(d) of the Official Information Act 1982, in that the information requested is, or will soon be publicly available.

Police data does not record if an offender has been apprehended; rather, it is recorded if the offender has been identified. While Police may know who the offender was, the offender may still be evading apprehension. However, Police can provide the number of Fleeing Driver Events where the offender was identified for the Auckland Police District. This information can be found in table one (below).
