I refer to your Official Information Act request of 14 November 2018 for information relating to offences for failing to stop at a stop sign.

You requested:

- I reside in NZ and I would like to request the following information: the number of infringement notices issued for 'failing to stop at a stop sign' by officers stationed in Warkworth in the 12 months ending 31.8.2018 and the dates that they were issued.*

Police cannot provide information for the number of infringements issued by officers stationed at Warkworth because the information is not available. However, Police can provide the number of infringement notices that were issued for failing to stop at a stop sign in the Warkworth Police Station area. Please refer to table one (below) for this information. Please note that for privacy reasons the information has been listed by month rather than the specific dates the infringement notices were issued.
