Thank you for your email dated 5 June 2013, which Auckland Transport received on the same date requesting the following information:

"any and all reports commissioned by your organisation, and I believe conducted by MRCagney, to study the feasibility of passenger rail services along the North Auckland Line beyond Swanson, that resulted in the recent decision by your organisation to run no services beyond the end of the electrified network at Swanson in the future.

I am interested in not only reports regarding services to Waitakere Township but also regarding the feasibility of services to Kumeu, Huapai, Waimauku and Helensville, or anywhere else along that stretch of railway."

The only report commissioned by Auckland Transport regarding public transport options, including rail, in the area north and west of Swanson is the MRCagney report "Waitakere to Huapai – Public Transport Options Assessment".

As per your request please find attached a copy of the MRCagney report "Waitakere to Huapai – Public Transport Options Assessment".

Should you believe that we have not responded appropriately to your request, you have the right in accordance with section 27(3) of the LGOIMA to make a complaint to the Office of the Ombudsmen to seek an investigation and review of the decision.
