Unusual count

Observations

Often buses will follow other buses into the tunnel after the signals have changed to amber or red.

3 mornings in a row - 3 city bound buses came through the tunnel at the same time from Haitaitai, resulting in the last bus blocking the Hataitai bound bus for a few cycles. 08.11.18 17.13pm - Pedestrian entered the tunnel followed by a bus in the same direction 1 minute later, then another in the other direction.

Summary

Low percentage of bus drivers run red lights at the Hataitai bus tunnel on the Pirie St side.

Most red light running occured during evening peak.

Our findings show whilst there is a low percentage of red light running, this behaviour is still very concerning.

Unusual count

Observations

Observed a low number of red light runners.

Many bus drivers run noticeably late amber signals when it appears they have sufficient time to stop.

Complaint has been received in the past regarding uncompliant/dangerous bus driver behaviour at this intersection.

Observed limosine travel Boulcott>Manners when green was displayed for Willis St buses. Driver took evasive action.

The week of 26-Nov shows and increase in buses along Willis St. Possibly a result of cruise ships in town.
